Additional educational seminars were held at Kenney Space Center and for the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation Beyond 34% Project.

Each event is designed to showcase our members' sustainability and recycling programs and inform others on best recycling practices. Our members love to share their successes and encourage others to start programs or improve existing ones.

RESEARCH PROJECTS:

The Florida Recycling Partnership Foundation supports research projects by contracting with major universities. In 2020, the Foundation released a study conducted by the University of Florida – "Examining Contamination Rates at Florida Materials Recovery Facilities." In 2022, we commissioned a study by UF - "Investigating the Economics of Current and Future Recycling Programs in Florida."
